

PUBLIC INTOXICATION

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL SUPERSEDE ALL PREVIOUS ORDINANCES RELATED TO PUBLIC INTOXICATION.

- (1) ANY PERSON WHO SHALL BE AND APPEAR IN AN INTOXICATED CONDITION IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE OR WITHIN THE CURTILAGE OF ANY PRIVATE RESIDENCE NOT HIS OWN OTHER THAN BY INVITATION OF THE OWNER OR LAWFUL OCCUPANT, WHICH CONDITION IS MADE MANIFEST BY UNRULINESS, BY INDECENT CONDITION OR ACT, OR BY VULGAR, PROFANE, LOUD, OR UNBECOMING LANGUAGE WILL BE IN VIOLATION OF PUBLIC INTOXICATION.
- (2) CONSUMING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON ANY CITY PROPERTY IS PROHIBITED AND SHALL CONSTITUTE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

VIOLATION OF ORDINANCE.

ANYONE IN VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
